This is not a complete list of side effects but more a list of more commonly experienced side effects. It is very important to call the Clinic (even if after hours) with these complaints. A nurse will call you back to discuss this further in detail and give you an appointment time, if necessary, to come in for evaluation.

◆ **DO NOT walk-in to clinic without an appointment to discuss problems.** Please let us schedule you a time to come in that will reduce your wait time and prevent an overload on us.

**When to call the Nurse**

- Temperature of 100.4°F or more. (Make sure you have a thermometer at home.)
- Any new signs of infection:
  1. New cough, shortness of breath, runny nose, sore throat, or chills.
  2. Any problems urinating such as pain, burning, frequency or urgency.
- Diarrhea that is uncontrolled with Imodium and/or more than 4 loose stools in one day. See Diarrhea information sheet.
- Constipation that is uncontrolled with Senekot and/or no bowel movement for 3 days. See Constipation information sheet.
- Nausea or vomiting that is uncontrolled with nausea medicine (usually compazine). See Nausea and Vomiting information sheet.
- Mouth Sores or sore throat that is not relieved with Magic Mouthwash and/or any white patches in the mouth or on the tongue. See Mouth Sores information sheet.
- Nose bleed that last for more than 10 minutes while holding pressure.
- Uncontrolled pain.
